Dear Secretary of State Gessler:

On October 10, 2014, the Colorado Department of Health Care Policy and Financing submitted MSB 14-06-25-A, Revision to the Medical Assistance Health Program Services and Supports Rule Concerning Amount, Scope and Duration of Ambulatory Surgery Centers, 10 CCR 2505-10, Section 8.570.3.D., to the Medical Services Board for permanent adoption (TN 2014-00884). Review of this rule text by staff at LexisNexis and the Secretary of State's Office uncovered the technical errors listed below:

- At § 8.570.5.A., there are two subparagraphs numbered 3.
- At § 8.570.5.A., there were two new subparagraphs for Board review added in clean text and not indicated in track changes.
- At § 8.570.5.9, the first paragraph under the heading is identified in the rule text as an unnumbered paragraph but should be cited as § 8.570.9.A.
- At 8.570.4.D., the D. is incorrectly included in this citation.

The technical corrections being requested for these errors are to:

- Insert, at § 8.570.5.A., the two new subparagraphs that were not identified in track changes on the rule document presented to the Medical Services Board as new text and number them 6. And 7.;
- Correct the numbering at § 8.570.5.A. by eliminating the duplicate 3 and renumbering subparagraphs 4. And 5.
- Insert the section number at § 8.570.9.A. that was inadvertently deleted and is currently identified as an unnumbered paragraph; and
- Remove the D. at § 8.570.4 so that it is consistent with the numbering scheme.

This correction is technical and non-substantive in nature and is submitted to you for publishing in the CCR pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103 of the State Administrative Procedure Act.
