Dear Mr. Whitney:

I have reviewed your inquiry regarding the typographical error adopted into the most recent "Rules Pertaining to the Feedlot Certification Act" during the December 2016 rule-making hearing.

Specifically, Part 10.2 of the final rule reads "Adopted December 13, 2016 – Effective January 30, 2016," where the latter "2016" is inaccurate, pre-dating the rule-making, and should read "2017."

It is my opinion that the error in the rules as filed by the State Board of Stock Inspection Commissioners, a typographical error, is a non-substantive error and is correctable under section 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), C.R.S.

Correcting the error by submitting the correct version of Part 10.2 does not change the substantive content of the regulations and addresses the fact that the effective date of the rule would have pre-dated the rule-making.

Because the correction of this error does not change the substantive content of the regulation, it does not change the previous Attorney General's opinion that this regulation is legal and constitutional.
