On November 17, 2016, amendments to Regulation Number 7 were adopted by the Air Quality Control Commission. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), the amended regulation and the Attorney General's opinion were submitted to the Secretary of State under Tracking Number 2016-00420. Subsequently, we discovered a clerical error that should be corrected before this rule becomes effective.

Specifically, Section XIX.B. identifies engines and boilers for IBM by reference number. The reference number for one piece of equipment mistakenly includes a "dash" rather than a "comma." IBM has no equipment identified by the number in its current form.

CURRENT: IBM (013-0006) – engines and boilers (pt 088, 090-001, 011, 095)

CORRECT: IBM (013-0006) – engines and boilers (pt 088, 090, 001, 011, 095)

Pursuant to the rulemaking provisions of the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act, clerical errors may be corrected upon submission of a request by the agency. C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II). I have reviewed this error and have determined that it is nonsubstantive.
