RE: Correction to Gaming Regulations, 1 CCR 207-1, Rule 4

Dear Ms. Maiolo:

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), the correction to the above-referenced rule is a result of an agency technical error that occurred in the filing process for Rule 4, Regulation 47.1-402.

The Rules Manager for the Colorado Division of Gaming, Ronni Hunter, was out of the country when the Gaming Commission adopted the amendment to Regulation 47.1-402. At the hearing, the Gaming Commission adopted the amendment with an additional phrase that was not in the original proposed rule draft. However, the individual who filed the final rule inadvertently used the original draft rule without the additional language that the commission adopted.

The original rule draft added “or any other criminal violation” to Regulation 47.1-402, but the Gaming Commission further added the highlighted phrase below when it adopted the rule. Due to a technical and clerical error, such language was left off the version of the rule amendment filed with the Secretary of State.

**RULE 4 RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF LICENSEES**

**47.1-402 Discovery of violations.**

Each licensee must immediately notify the Division of the discovery of a violation or of a suspected violation of article 47.1 of title 12, C.R.S., or the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, or any other criminal violation OCCURRING AT A CASINO ESTABLISHMENT.

Because the highlighted language was adopted by the Gaming Commission, it needs to be added to Regulation 47.1-402.
