Rules 4.2.2 through 4.4.4.8, 1 CCR 303-1

Dear Mr. Williams:

I have reviewed the corrections to the accompanying Rules , and determined that the matters being corrected are nonsubstantive errors, and that the corrections are necessary to insure that the published rules and corresponding opinion conform to the adopted rules, pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(d), C.R.S. (2017).

The corrections address a failure to properly renumber portions of the rules, adopted November 9, 2017, submitted under Tracking Number 2017-00650, specifically:

Rule 4.2.2 was used twice and as a result rules 4.2.2 through 4.2.8. should be renumbered.

Rule 4.2.2 identifying "security and associated filtering" should be changed to Rule 4.2.3.

Rules 4.2.3 through Rule 4.2.5. should be changed to Rules 4.2.4 through 4.2.6

Rules 4.2.5.1 should be changed to 4.2.6.1.

Rules 4.2.5.1.1 through 4.2.5.1.5 should be changed to 4.2.6.1.1 through 4.2.6.1.5 respectively.

Rules 4.2.6 and subparts 4.2.6.1 through 4.2.6.4 should be changed to Rules 4.2.7 and subparts 4.2.7.1 through 4.2.7.4. respectively.

Rule 4.2.7 “Connectivity standards” should be changed to Rule 4.2.8; subparts 4.2.7.1 and 4.2.7.2 should be changed to 4.2.8.1 and 4.2.8.2 respectively. Sub-subparts 4.2.7.2.1 through 4.2.7.2.5 should be changed to 4.2.8.2.1 through 4.2.8.2.5 respectively.

The item located below section 4.4.3 “Energy Management Plan” which provides that “-Energy programs assist with creating a culture of energy efficiency within a school .Reference Energy Star Guidelines for Energy Management to help develop a plan.” was not previously assigned a number. It should be numbered 4.4.3.1.

Rule number 4.4.4. is assigned to section “Other Energy Efficient Options.” as it was not previously numbered.

Rule number 4.4.4.1 is assigned to “ENERGY STAR Labeled HVAC/Mechanical Systems.” as it was not previously numbered.

Rule number 4.4.4.2 was assigned to “Windows, doors, and skylights (collectively known as fenestration).” as it was not previously assigned a number.

Rules 4.4.1.4 through 4.4.3.2 (including subparts) were numbered incorrectly and should be changed to Rules 4.4.4.1-4.4.4.8. respectively (including subparts).

In section 4.4.4.8 the acronym “PBD” was assigned the letter “s” to the end of “PBD” due to a typographical error resulting in “PBD’s”.
