Dear Mr. Williams:

I have reviewed your inquiry regarding the error made in the Rules of the Director of the Professions and Occupations, Office of Barber and Cosmetology Licensure ("Director") adopted on December 15, 2017 and submitted to the Secretary of State on or about the same date. It is my opinion that the error in the rules as filed by the Director in Rules 7.11 and 7.12, and their subsections, is non-substantive. The error is a simple typeface error in that the numeral heading 7.11 was duplicated in place of what should have been heading 7.12. This is a non-substantive error and is correctable under section 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), C.R.S. Correcting the error by submitting the correct version of Rules 7.11 and 7.12 does not change the substantive content of the regulations, nor does it change the actual effective date of the regulations. Since the correction of this error does not change the substantive content of the regulation, it does not change the previous Attorney General opinion that this regulation is legal and constitutional.
