Dear Mr. Williams:

I have reviewed your inquiry regarding the error made in the State Electrical Board ("Board") rules adopted on May 24, 2017 and submitted to the Secretary of State on or about the same date. It is my opinion that the error in the rules as filed by the Board, in Rule 2.0 and its subsections, is non-substantive. The error is a simple typeface error reflecting an older edition of the National Electrical Code. The correct year of the National Electrical Code, as adopted by the Board, is 2017. This is a non-substantive error and is correctable under section 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), C.R.S. Correcting the error by submitting the correct version of Rule 2.0 does not change the substantive content of the regulations, nor does it change the actual effective date of the regulations. Since the correction of this error does not change the substantive content of the regulation, it does not change the previous Attorney General opinion that this regulation is legal and constitutional.
