
On March 3, 2018, Governor Hickenlooper signed into law the Colorado Department of Revenue, Lottery Division HB 18-1027, "Relocate Title 24 Lottery to New Title 44." HB 18-1027 serves the purpose of reorganizing the Lottery Division's statutory provisions from Title 24, Article 35 and to Title 44, Article 40, State Lottery Division. This relocation of the Lottery Division's enabling statutes, renders all references to Title 24, Article 35 within 1 Colo. Code of Regulations 206-1 no longer accurate. As a result, the proposed correction is to update all statutory references to the Title 24, Article 35 contained in 1 Colo. Code of Regulations 206-1 with the now effective statutory citations at Title 44, Article 40.

Pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(I)(B), C.R.S., the following corrections to the above-referenced 1 Colo. Code of Regulations 206-1 are occasioned by the General Assembly's relocation of Title 24, Article 35, State Lottery Division and such corrections meet the conditions specified in section 24-4-103(11)(I)(B), C.R.S. Attached to the Division of Lottery's filing is a redline containing these corrections.
