RE: Correction of Department of Revenue Regulations 1 CCR 201-18 Rule 39-
28.8-101 Pursuant to HB18-1023

To whom it may concern:

On March 22, 2018, Governor Hickenlooper signed into law HB18-1023, Concerning the Nonsubstantive Relocation of Laws Related to Legalized Marijuana from Title 12, Colorado Revised Statutes, as part of the Organizational Recodification of Title 12. HB18-1023 serves the purpose of removing Department of Revenue statutory provisions from title 12 and into title 44, at article 12. This relocation of the Department of Revenue's enabling statutes, 12-43.4-101, *et. seq.*, C.R.S., renders all references to 12-43.4-103, C.R.S., within 1 CCR 201-18, Rule 39-28.8-101, no longer accurate. As a result, the proposed correction is to update all statutory references to section 12-43.4-103, C.R.S., contained in 1 CCR 201-18, Rule 39-28.8-101, with the now effective statutory citations at section 44-12-103, C.R.S.


