Pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(I)(A), C.R.S., the Director of Professions and Occupations within the Department of Regulatory Agencies requests a correction to the statutory citations in the Colorado Office of Massage Therapy Licensure Rules and Regulations, 3 CCR 722-1. Corrections to the statutory citations are being implemented in response to the passage of HB19-1172, effective October 1, 2019, which recodifies and reorganizes Title 12, C.R.S. The corrections are incorporated in SOS Tracking No. 2019-00344. Typographical and other non-substantive errors have also been corrected pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), C.R.S.

I submit that sections 24-4-103(11)(d)(II) and (I)(II)(A), C.R.S., apply to these non-substantive rule changes and request that the Secretary of State make the changes incorporated in SOS Tracking No. 2019-00344 in the Code of Colorado Regulations.
