Dear Secretary of State Griswold:

On September 25, 2019, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (“CDPHE”) submitted SOS Tracking No. 2019-00554, Proposed Amendments to 6 CCR 1007-1, Part 6, X-ray imaging in the healing arts, Part 2, Registration of radiation machines, facilities and services, and Part 12, Fees for radiation control services. At the rulemaking hearing on November 20, 2019, the board adopted the proposed rule.

It has come to CDPHE’s attention that the proposed rule contains an error in two locations—both errors concern internal cross-references. The errors occurred because CDPHE originally proposed to strike rule 2.6.1.3, but 2.6.1.3 was ultimately retained. Though retained, the conforming amendments to honor the renumbering of the 2.6.1 series did not consistently occur, i.e. 2.6.1.4 and Appendix 2D.2 were not updated. The Board voted to retain provision 2.6.1.3 and thus, it is appropriate to correct the cross reference to identify the correct numbers. The cross-reference at 2.6.1.4 and Appendix 2D.2 are informational only, but the incorrect cross-references could create confusion. The corrections should be as follows:

- The opening clause of the adopted rule 2.6.1.4 reads, “For any radiographic x-ray system used on a living human (consistent with 2.6.1.2, and 2.6.1.4 through 2.6.1.13),” but it should read, “For any radiographic x-ray system used on a living human (consistent with 2.6.1.2, 2.6.1.3 and 2.6.1.5 through 2.6.1.14)”;
- Appendix 2D.2 reads, “Is certified by the Department as a State of Colorado-registered limited scope operator, to conduct only those radiographic examinations specified in Section 2.6.1.3 and having satisfactorily completed.” but it should read, “Is certified by the Department as a State of Colorado-registered limited scope operator, to

conduct only those radiographic examinations specified in Section 2.6.1.4 and having satisfactorily completed.”


