

Statutory citation "8-1-140," should be added to the last line of Rule 8.5, between citations "8-1-116," and "8-4-120," with the corrected line to read: "Violators may be subject to penalties under C.R.S. §§ 8-1-116, 8-1-140, 8-4-120, and/or 8-6-115."
