To Whom it May Concern:

This office represents the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Commission ("CPW").

On July 16, 2020, CPW adopted the regulations associated with Rule Opinion 2020-00377. Our office identified a typo in the adopted rules. Specifically, the adopted rules state: "A disabled resident may obtain an Independence annual parks pass pursuant to 33-12-106 (b), C.R.S." The correct statutory citation should be 33-12-106(1)(b), C.R.S.

Please accept this letter as CPW's request for your office to correct the above-referenced typo pursuant to § 24-4-103(11)(d)(2), CRS, which enables agencies to correct non-substantive errors in adopted rules prior to publication. *Id.* ("Upon written request of an agency, the secretary of state shall correct typographical and other nonsubstantive errors appearing in the rules as filed by such agency that occur after final adoption of the rules by the agency during the preparation of such rules for publication in order to conform the published rules with the adopted rules.").
