RE: Correction Request Tracking No. 2020-00881

Dear Secretary of State Griswold:

On February 27, 2020, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (“CDPHE”) submitted SOS Tracking No. 2020-00096, Amendments to 6 C.C.R. 1015-4, Chapters One – Four, Statewide Emergency Medical and Trauma Care System. The board adopted the proposed permanent rule on April 14, 2020.

It has come to CDPHE’s attention that the adopted rule filed under this tracking number contains a minor typographical error. 6 C.C.R. 1015-4, Chapter Three, 303.7.A.(5) currently reads:

The facility shall provide a neurosurgical on-call schedule, dedicated only to that facility, available 24 hours per day, and either a posted backup call schedule or a contingency plan that includes bypass and transfer guidelines with another designated Level I, or *in the even that* no other Level I is available, then to a Level II facility with the necessary resources to meet the patient's needs.

“[I]n the even that,” should be corrected to “in the event that.” This is not a substantive change, and the Board of Health adopted language during the rulemaking hearing in April that said, “in the event that.” Correcting this typographical error improves clarity for readers.

On November 4, 2020, CDPHE requested an administrative change to SOS Tracking No. 2020-00096 in order to correct the error designated above. A corrected version has been submitted.

This correction is technical and non-substantive in nature and is submitted to you for publishing in the C.C.R. pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II) of the State Administrative Procedure Act.
