ADOPTION ORDER OF OFFICE OF BARBER AND COSMETOLOGY LICENSURE RULES

The attached rules Chapters 1 through 11 are hereby adopted for the Office of Barber and Cosmetology Licensure.

Statement of Basis: The statutory basis for the rules is to carry out the provisions of the Barbers and Cosmetologists Practice Act at §§ 12-8-101 et seq., C.R.S. ("the Act").

Statement of Purpose: The purpose of this rulemaking is to repeal all existing rules and replace the content for further clarification in obtaining licensure, maintaining licensure/registration, prohibited acts, infection control requirements and adopt the amendments made by recent legislation in HB17-1196.

Statutory Authority: The specific statutory authority that authorizes the rulemaking is § 12-8-108(1)(a), C.R.S., and § 24-4-103, C.R.S.

These rules are promulgated in order to carry out the powers and duties of the Director of the Division of Professions and Occupations, Department of Regulatory Agencies pursuant to Article 8 of Title 12, C.R.S.
