

**STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE
FOR
REPEAL OF EMPLOYMENT VERIFICATION LAW RULES
7 C.C.R. 1103-3**

BASIS: C.R.S. § 8-1-107(2)(p), § 8-1-103(3), and § 8-1-111 provide the Director of the Division of Labor Standards and Statistics with the authority to adopt rules and regulations related to employers, employees, and places of employment.

REPEAL OF RULE: The Division proposes to repeal the Employment Verification Law Rules, 7 C.C.R. 1103-3 in the course of this rulemaking. This rule needs to be rewritten, as it pertains to the operation of C.R.S. § 8-2-122, which was recently amended by House Bill 16-1114.

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(4)(b), the Director finds that: 1) there is a demonstrated need for the repeal of the rule, and 2) the proper statutory authority exists for the repeal of the rule.
