## PERMANENT RULE REPEAL ADOPTION ORDER

### Office of Private Investigator Licensure

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

##### Basis

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking is pursuant to sections 12-20-204(1), 12-160-109(2)(a), and 24-4-103, C.R.S. The basis for the repeal of these rules is set forth in section 24-34-104(19)(a)(VIII), C.R.S., to repeal the Office of Private Investigator Licensure within the Division of Professions and Occupations, Department of Regulatory Agencies effective September 1, 2020.

##### Purpose

The purpose of this rule repeal is to effectuate the veto of Colorado House Bill 20-1207 (Concerning the Continuation of the Regulation of Private Investigators) by Governor Jared Polis, which ended the regulation of private investigators effective September 1, 2020.

The repeal of these permanent rules is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law. Therefore, I hereby repeal these permanent rules and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
