## PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

### Office of Audiology Licensure

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rule is promulgated in compliance with section 12-20-203, C.R.S., providing licensees the ability to change the status of their license to inactive, and clarifies the requirements to reactivate an inactive license.

#### Basis

The basis for this rule is to carry out the provisions of the Audiologist Practice Act at section 12-210-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S. The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking are pursuant to sections 12-20-204(1), 12-20-203, 12-210-109(4), and 24-4-103, C.R.S.

#### Purpose

The purpose of adopting revisions to Rule 1.3, is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law. Therefore, I hereby adopt this rule on a permanent basis, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
