PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

Office of Barber and Cosmetology Licensure

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rule is promulgated to implement Colorado Senate Bill 22-116 (*Concerning the ability of an individual to obtain an occupational credential through the occupational credential portability program*), which amends the Red Tape Reduction Act (Colorado House Bill 20-1326/Section 12-20-202, C.R.S.).

Basis

The basis for this rule is to carry out the provisions of Colorado Senate Bill 22-116, and the Barber and Cosmetologist Practice Act at section 12-105-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S. The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking are pursuant to sections 12-20-202(3), 12-20-204(1), 12-105-106(1), and 24-4-103, C.R.S.

Purpose

The purpose of adopting revisions to Rule 1.4, on a permanent basis is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law (Colorado Senate Bill 22-116). Therefore, I hereby adopt this rule as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
