PURPOSE

~~These~~**This** rules establish**es** the certification and operational requirements for the conduct of certified third party motorcycle rider skills testers.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

~~—**Accord Certificate:** Means a document issued by an insurance company that summarizes essential information about the insurance coverage provided.~~

a) **Department:** The Department of Revenue.

b) **DRIVES[®]:** ~~-Driver License Record Identification Vehicle Enterprise Solution. -Used as the computer database by the Division of Motor Vehicle.~~

c) **DTE:** Driver Testing and Education within the Driver License Section of the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles.

d) **“Motorcycle License Written Examination ” or “(Examination):”** ~~T~~means the DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination or an electronic equivalent.

e) **MSF:** Motorcycle Safety Foundation.

~~a) The Department has adopted testing and course standards from MSF.~~

f) **Organization:** A third party testing organization to become an RSTO that has yet to be certified as a RSTO by the Department.

g) **Rider Skills Test (RST):** A motorcycle operating skills test in which the applicant demonstrates the applicant's ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable care and control in the operation of the motorcycle while observed and graded by an RST Tester.

~~b) **Rider Skills Tester (RST Tester):** An individual third party motorcycle rider skills tester certified by the Department to administer- (including proctoring and grading) a Rider Skills Test and/or an individual certified by the Department to administer a DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination. (DR2256 or DR2321) or an individual certified by the Department to administer both a Rider Skills Test and DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321).~~

~~e)h) **Rider Skills Test (RST):** A motorcycle operating skills test in which the applicant demonstrates the applicant's ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable care and control in the operation of the motorcycle while observed and graded by an RST Tester.~~

~~e)i) **Rider Skills Testing Certification (RST Certification):** A certification issued by the Department authorizing an individual or third party testing organization to administer Rider Skills Tests and DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations (DR2256 or DR2321) to applicants seeking a motorcycle endorsement.~~

~~e)j) **Rider Skills Testing Course (RST Course):** A course measured and painted according to Motorcycle Safety Foundation (~~MSF~~) standards and pre-approved by the Department for use in RST testing.~~

~~k) **Rider Skills Testing Organization (RSTO):** A third party testing organization certified by the Department to administer Rider Skills Tests and DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations (DR2256 or DR2321) through an RST Tester.~~

~~l) **Third Party Exam Completion Statement (TPE):** Form generated by DRIVES[®] as a receipt to the applicant that the RST Tester has entered exam information into the syDRIVESstem.~~

~~f)m) **Transaction Completion Statement (TCS):** Form generated by DRIVES[®] that ~~to~~ indicates data was entered into the ~~Third Party Access Portal~~ DRIVES for a submitted ~~each~~ exam. ~~submitted.~~~~

(150) APPLICABILITY

This Rule 9 applies to any individual tester or third party testing organization that offers a statutorily-mandated examination to a person seeking a motorcycle endorsement.

(200) GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RSTOs

a) Only an organization certified by the Department pursuant to this Rule 9 can employ an individual to administer an RST, ~~a DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321)~~, or issue documents indicating test test completion.

1. An organization seeking certification as an RSTO must complete and submit a typed Department approved application form.
2. All certifications are valid for the fiscal year (from July 1st through expire on June 30th of the following each year) issued.

b) A third party organization n RSTO must enter into a written contract with the Department in order to be certified by the Department. ~~The written contract shall provide that an RSTO must hold the State harmless from liability resulting from an RST.~~

~~e) An RSTO must hold the State harmless from liability resulting from an RST.~~

~~e)c) An RSTO must notify the Department in writing within 3three business days of: ~~(1) an employee's change in Examination or RST Tester status; (2) or the date that a certified employee is no longer employed departure from by the RSTO; (3) a, DRIVES[®] lock out; (4), or departure from the RSTO, cessation of its business; or (5), or~~ any change in directors, owners, or managers.~~

~~e)d) An RSTO must notify the Department in writing within 3three business days of the loss of use of an RST Course or the addition of an RST Course, or if an RST Course no longer meets the requirements listed in subsection 300 of this rule.~~

- ~~f)e) All DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations (DR2256 or DR2321) and RST testing must be equivalent to examinations-tests administered by the Department.~~
- ~~g)f) Tests administered by RST Testers ~~ing~~ must be consistent with RST -Tester training and RST testers only must use only the DR 2610 Rider Skills Test Score Sheet (DR2610) provided by the Department may be used.~~
- ~~h) An organization applying applicant for certification is responsible for any fees or costs associated with RST training and certification.~~
- ~~i)g) An RSTO cannot administer an RST or an Examination; only an RST Tester can administer an RST or RST or DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321) for his/her RSTO employer.~~
- ~~j)h) Every RSTO organization's owner and manager must complete records management training provided by the Department prior to certification before the organization may be certified as an RSTO.~~
- ~~k)i) An RSTO must comply with, and ensure that any RST Tester it employs complies with, applicable Colorado Revised Statutes, Rules and Regulations, and Department orders.~~
- ~~l)j) An RSTO must provide the Department with the RSTO's current physical and mailing addresses, unique email addresses for the RSTO and each employee, a contact phone number, and the name of one contact person who is an employee or principal of the RSTO.~~
1. An RSTO must notify the Department in writing within 3three business days of any change in its physical place of business and mailing address, contact phone number, and contact person.
- ~~m)k) An All employees of an RSTO must provide the Department have a Colorado Bureau of Investigation background check and an original signature on file with the Department for all each of its certified employees.~~
- ~~n) An RSTO must submit a current Colorado Bureau of Investigation background check for each employee annually with its renewal packet.~~
- ~~o)l) The Department may deny or revoke the certification of an RSTO if an owner, director, or of manager has been convicted of a felony or any offense involving moral turpitude. Conviction includes a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or a deferred sentence, however provided that a person who receives a deferred sentence shall not be deemed to have been convicted if the person has successfully completed a deferred sentence.~~
1. In determining whether to deny or revoke a certification, the Department will consider the factors contained in section 24-5-101(4), C.R.S.
- ~~p)m) Insurance Requirements: An RSTO must have proof of current and valid general liability insurance and worker's compensation insurance in the form of an insurance certificate of Insurance, if required by the Workers' Compensation Act [Sections 8-40-101, et. seq. C.R.S.], on file with the Department at all times.~~
1. The Department must be listed on the general liability insurance policy as a secondary insured.
 2. ~~An RSTO must ensure that the insurance company sends the information required in this paragraph (p) insurancec to the Department.~~

- ~~23.~~ Not less than 30 days prior to expiration of the current insurance coverage period, the RSTO must Failure to provide an insurance Accord Certificate updated insurance information to the Department for the period following the current insurance coverage period. within 30 days of prior to expiration
3. The RSTO must notify the Department immediately upon cancellation of an insurance policy.
4. Failure to maintain current insurance coverage is grounds for suspension, and such suspension may be in effect until a current Accord insurance Certificate is provided to the Department.
- ~~n)~~ In the event an RSTO's certification is not renewed, or is revoked or suspended, all individual RST Tester certifications for that RSTO will be revoked, or suspended, or not renewed.
- o) The Department will issue a unique tester number, logien, and password to each RST Tester. RST Testers must use only their assigned number, logon, and/or password and must not authorize another person to use their number. Unauthorized use of an assigned number by any RSTO employee by an RST Tester may result in revocation or suspension of the RSTO's certification.
- p) The RSTO is responsible for must -ensuring that complete and accurate information is entered into DRIVES[®] by an the RST Tester.
- q) The RSTO must ensure a reversed or multiple TCSs Transaction Completion Statements are stapled to supporting score sheets/written examinations. The RSTO must ensure multiple TCSs, or TCSs that have been incorrectly entered from pass to fail or fail to pass requiring the result be reversed, are stapled to supporting score sheets/written examinations.
- r) The RSTO must ensure that the "Third Party Exam Completion Statement" TPE is provided to the applicant applicant by the RST Tester.
- ~~s)~~ The RSTO The RSTO must ensure that nothing marks or covers the TCS barcode, and ensure that the barcode is readable by a barcode scanner.
- ~~u)~~ An RSTO must refer the following to a Colorado driver license office:
1. an applicant requesting a DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (~~DR2256 or DR2321~~) after failing a paper version of the Examination 4four times. 4 failed attempts;
 2. an applicant who does not have a valid with an invalid driver license and who is requesting an Examination or RSTny test; or
 3. an applicant unable to produce a valid photo ID.
- v) RSTOs must complete and submit a typed DR 2067 New RST Employee Request for a prospective new RST Tester prior to requesting training or certification for a prospective of the RST Tester.

(250) GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RST TESTERS

- a) Only an individual certified by the Department as an RST Tester pursuant to this Rule 9 can administer an RST, an form DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination, (DR2256 or DR2321), or issue documents indicating test completion.

1. An individual seeking certification as an RST Tester must:
 - i. complete and submit a typed form-DR 2068 the most current Department approved "BOST/RST/Continuing Education Training Registration Form;" (DR 2068) application form;
 - ii. ~~have had a valid driver license issued by any state for at least 4 years and~~ be at least 21 years of age;
 - iii. have a valid Colorado Driver License, ~~or a valid driver license issued by any state, that has been valid for at least 4 years;~~
 - iv. complete and pass all Department required training; and
 - v. be employed by an RSTO.

2. An RST Tester need not be certified ~~to administer the Examination as a written knowledge tester~~ in order to be an RST Tester, ~~however, only an RST Tester so certified can administer a DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321).~~

3. An applicant for RST Tester certification, or his or her employer, is responsible for any fees or costs associated with RST training and certification.

4. All RST testers must complete ~~Refresher Training~~ continuing education and pass a test administered by the Department within every other calendar year after the year of certification ~~two calendar years.~~

- ~~All certifications expire on June 30th of each year.~~

5. ~~In order to maintain certification through the Department, RST Testers must conduct a minimum of 40ten RST tests every fiscal year (July 1st through June 30th). An RST Tester who fails to conduct 40ten RST tests within a fiscal year will not be re-certified to administer an RST test until he/she has completed and passed continuing education.~~

- ~~5.6. An RST Tester certification is valid for the fiscal year (July 1st through June 30th) issued.~~

- b) ~~An~~ RST Tester may be employed by more than one RSTO. ~~An~~ RST Tester employed by more than one RSTO will be issued a separate ~~certification tester~~ number and, logion/password for each RSTO employing the RST Tester. ~~An~~ RST Tester certification is valid only while the ~~tester-Tester~~ is employed by the RSTO listed on the certificate.

- c) Testing of applicants must be consistent with RST Tester training and RST Testers must use only ~~the the form DDR 2610~~ Rider Skills Test Score Sheet ~~(DR2610)~~ provided by the Department.

- d) ~~An~~ RST Tester must comply with applicable Colorado Revised Statutes, Rules and Regulations, and Department orders.

- e) The Department may deny or revoke certification of an ~~individual or an RST Tester~~ who has been convicted of a felony or any offense involving moral turpitude. Conviction includes a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or a deferred sentence, ~~however provided that~~ a person who receives a deferred sentence shall not be deemed to have been convicted if the person has successfully completed a deferred sentence.

1. In determining whether to deny or revoke a certification, the Department will consider the factors contained in section 24-5-101(4), C.R.S.
- f) An RST Tester must follow the Department's standards when administering an RST or an ~~DR2256 or DR2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321)~~.

RST Testers must use only their ~~assigned number, logon and/ password to access DRIVES,~~ and must not authorize ~~any other another~~ person to use ~~his/her login password or unique testertheir~~ number. ~~Unauthorized use of an assigned number, number or logon/password may resultmay result in revocation or suspension of the RST Tester's certifications.~~
 - h) An RST Tester must refer the following to a Colorado driver license office:
 1. an applicant requesting a ~~Motorcycle License Written Examinationwritten knowledge test~~ after ~~failing a paper version of the Motorcycle License Written Examination 4-four timesfailed attempts~~;
 2. an applicant ~~who does not have a valid with an invalid~~ driver license ~~and who is~~ requesting any test; ~~and/or~~
 3. an applicant unable to produce a valid photo ID.
 - i) ~~i) —~~ An RST Tester cannot administer any RST ~~or Motorcycle License Written Examination test~~ to a member of their immediate family. "Immediate family" is defined in section 42-1-102(43.5), C.R.S.
 - ~~All must verify the applicant has a valid Driver's License and valid Motorcycle permit in their immediate possession and is eligible to take the test.~~
 - ~~ii) An# RSTs Testers Testers mustare responsible for entering complete and accurate information into DRIVES®.~~

(300) RST COURSE SITE REQUIREMENTS

- a) An RSTO must ensure that its RST Course meets Departmental requirements ~~for the RST. The Department has adopted testing and course standards contained in Motorcycle Safety Foundation, Inc., MSF Rider Skill Test, Motorcycles & 3-wheel Motorcycles, Examiner Study Guide, SixthSeventh Printing: July 20146, at 12-4920, incorporated herein by reference.~~ ~~for the RST.~~ ~~A copy of the MSF Rider Skill Test, Motorcycles & 3-wheel Motorcycles may be obtained by contacting Motorcycle Safety Foundation, 2 Jenner, Suite 150, Irvine, CA 92618-3806 ("MSF Examiner Study Guide").~~
- b) An RSTO must provide the Department a signed ~~form DDR 2149-2149 "RST Land Use Authorization" for each RST Course used by the RSTO to administer an RST, memorandum DR 2149 (format provided by the Department),~~ authorizing the RSTO to paint ~~theeach~~ RST Course and to administer RST ~~s Tests~~ on the property.
- c) ~~An The "DR 2149 RST Land Use Authorization" — memorandum DR-2149 for an RST Course~~ must be filed with the Department before an RST Course will be approved.
- d) ~~Only~~ RST Courses ~~must be~~ approved by the Department ~~may be used to administer the -prior to~~ RST ~~s Testing~~.

- e) When in use, an the RST Course surface must be ~~safe,~~ free from defects ~~;~~ ~~and free from~~ foreign matter including, but not limited to, debris, sand, gravel, water, ice, and snow ~~;~~ ~~and any object not authorized in the MSF Examiner Study Guide, pages 12-2019.~~
- f) An RST Course that measures over ~~1/2 1/2~~ of ~~anone~~ inch outside MSF standards, as referenced in the "Range Layout" portion of the MSF "MSF Examiner Study Guide, pages 12-2019", longer or shorter than the course that was previously approved by the Department is out of standard does and no longer not meets Department requirements, ~~and ;~~ approval of RST Testing on that course will be ~~summarily~~ suspended.
- g) All RST Course markings must be plainly visible and accurate.

(400) RST TESTING REQUIREMENTS

- a) An RSTO must allow the Department to conduct random inspections and audits of the organization's RST testing records, procedures, and RST Ccourse(s).
- b) Prior to administering an RST, RST Testers must ~~ensure by verifying~~ verify in the system DRIVES® that the applicant has a valid driver license and a valid motorcycle instruction permit in his/her immediate possession.
- c) An RSTO must ensure that RSTs are administered only by certified RST Testers certified to administer an RST and employed by the RSTO ~~administer an RST on behalf of that RSTO.~~
- d) RSTs Testing may be administered only must be done during daylight hours. For purposes of this rule, daylight hours means the period between one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset.

~~f)e) An RSTO and RST Tester must ensure that all testing forms are completed correctly and accurately prior to entering information into DRIVES.~~

~~g)f) The 2-Wheel/3-Wheel Motorcycle Skills Test Completion TCSTransaction Completion Statement (DR2713) must not be partially or fully completed entered until after an applicant has completed and passed the RST.~~

~~h)g) An RST Tester's entry signature of information into the Third Party Access Portal DRIVES, for generation of a TCS, on a 2-Wheel/3-Wheel Motorcycle Skills Test Completion Transaction Completion Statement (DR2713) constitutes a representation by the RST Tester that the applicant whose name is entered has completed into the system on the DR2713 took and passed the RST.~~

~~i)h) RST Testers must note all failures on an the applicant's -DR 2610 Rider Skills Test Score Sheet (DR-2610) and report enter the failure into the system DRIVES® immediately to the Department within 24 hours of the test.~~

- ~~l)k) All portions of the RST Test must be completed consecutively by anthe applicant. Only after an The applicant has must completecompleted the RST Test may before another applicant is allowed to begin an RST Test on the same Course RST Course.~~
- ~~m)l) Applicants must take the RST Test on a properly equipped and maintained motorcycle that meets state requirements for equipment, safety, insurance, and mMotor vVehicle rRegistration.~~
- ~~n)m) _____ An applicant under 18 years of age must wear a helmet that meets the standards described in section 42-4-1502(4.5) C.R.S. while testing.~~
- ~~o)n) An RST Tester must not administer more than one complete RST per day to an applicant.~~
- ~~p) If an applicant fails an RST, the RST Tester must enter the information into the system DRIVES® immediately. write "fail" and the date of the test on the back of the motorcycle permit with a permanent marker.~~
- ~~q) RST Testers must not administer an RST or a DR2256 or DR2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR2256 or DR2321) to a member of his/her immediately family, as defined in section 42-1-102(43.5) C.R.S.~~
- ~~r)o) An RST administered by an RST Tester must be equivalent to testing administered by the Department.~~
- ~~s)p) RST Testers must ensure that applicants who take apass the 2-Wheel/ or 3-Wheel RST receive a completion transaction statement a TCS "Third Party Exam Completion Statement" reflecting whether that reflects that it is for athe vehicle used in the test was a 2-Wheel or 3-Wheel vehicle 2-Wheel/3-Wheel vehicle.~~

(500) MOTORCYCLE LICENSE WRITTEN EXAMINATION ~~(DR_2256 OR DR_2321)~~

- a) RST Testers administering the ~~form DR_2256 or DR_2321~~ Motorcycle License Written Examination (~~DR_2256 or DR_2321~~) must immediately issue the TPE General Motorcycle/3-Wheel Motorcycle Written Knowledge Testing Completion Statement (DR2439) "Third Party Exam Completion Statement" to the applicant upon successful completion of the test. The TPE General Motorcycle/3-Wheel Motorcycle Written Knowledge Testing Completion Statement (DR2439) "Third Party Exam Completion Statement" form is valid for 30-180 days from the date of issue. Only the certified RST Testers s who administered~~proctored~~ the test Examination may enter sign this information into DRIVES® form.
- b) RST Testers administering ~~Motorcycle form DR_2256 or DR_2321~~ Motorcycle License Written EExaminations (~~DR_2256 or DR_2321~~) must:
 1. ~~administer and proctor e~~ Examination tests only at a location pre-approved by the Department;
 2. ensure that applicants do not access any unauthorized assistance, including but not limited to, written material, cell phones, or electronic devices, or communicate with any unauthorized person while testing;
 3. require applicants to write their first and last name(s), date of birth, and the date of the test Examination in the information box provided on the form ~~DDR 2256 or DR 2321~~ Motorcycle License Written Examination (~~DR2256 or DR2321~~), and interpreters, including an RST Tester acting as an interpreter, must write their first and last name(s) and driver license number on the back of the paper ? test;

4. require a correct score of 80% or higher to pass;
 5. grade correctly using the score key and a red pen when grading a DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination;
 6. ~~not administer provide more than up to four~~ DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations tests per applicant in total, and no more than two ~~Examination tests~~ to an applicant per day. ~~-. If an applicant fails four~~ DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations written tests, all subsequent tests must be taken at a Department driver license office; and
 7. ensure that an applicant who fails an test-DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination is not administered the same version of the test-DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination in any subsequent attempt. If an applicant misses more than 50% of the questions on a first ~~test~~ attempt, the applicant must wait until the next day to test take the DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination again.
- c) Applicants may use an interpreter for the ~~form-DR-2256 or DR-2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR-2256 or DR-2321).~~ An RST Tester may serve as an interpreter. Any interpreter must be arranged for by the applicant and any cost associated with the use of an interpreter is the responsibility of the applicant.
 - d) An interpreter must be at least 16 years old and show an unexpired driver license from any state in the United States.
 - e) ~~An The RST Tester or other~~ interpreter ~~can interpret in the required language and may can~~ only interpret the questions and answer choices.
 - f) ~~DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations (DR-2256 or DR-2321)~~ must not be used as “practice” or “pre” tests or for any other unauthorized purpose.
 - g) DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examinations (DR-2256 or DR-2321) may not be copied outside the physical facilities of the RSTO, unless the ~~test~~Examinations remain under the direct supervision and control of the RSTO.
 - h) ~~General Motorcycle/3-Wheel Motorcycle Written Knowledge Testing Completion Statements TCSs (DR2439)~~ must not be ~~partially or fully completed entered into DRIVES®~~ until after a student has completed and passed the DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination. (DR 2256 or DR-2321).
 - i) RST Testers administering the DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR-2256 or DR-2321) must confirm upon renewal of their certification to administer Motorcycle License Written Examinations that they have the most current version of ~~test~~Examinations/ and corresponding Examination keys.
 - j) ~~Examinations Tests~~ must be administered (including proctoring and grading) by an RST Tester with a certification to administer an DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination. Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR-2256 or DR-2321).
 - k) ~~The RST Tester must correctly grade the Motorcycle License Written Examination (DR-2256 for 2-Wheel or DR-2321 for 3-Wheel) test.~~ The RST Tester administering the Examination signing entering information to produce the General Motorcycle/3-Wheel Motorcycle Written Knowledge Testing Completion Transaction Completion TCS Statement (DR2439) is responsible for the accurate grading of the ~~test~~DR 2256 or DR 2321 Motorcycle License Written Examination.

~~All written knowledge testing must be equivalent to examinations administered by the Department.~~

a) Departmental audits may be conducted at the RSTO's office, the Department's office, or at another location as determined by the auditor.

b) The Department will conduct audits as often as the Department deems necessary to review all required records. Records will be checked for accuracy and completeness, including, but not limited to, missing ~~or voided~~ records, and, in the case of ~~control numbered documents~~ Transaction Completion Statement TCSs, for ~~numeric~~ chronological filing sequence separated by month.

c) ~~An~~ RSTO must cooperate with the Department, including allowing access to Examination and RST testing areas, and supplying student names and Examination and RST testing records, results, and any other items requested by the Department.

d) RSTO records must be accessible during the RSTO's normal business hours.

e) ~~R~~STO records must be provided or made available to a Department representative upon request.

f) An RSTO must receive a score of 80% or higher to pass an audit. Records management and/or continuing education ~~may~~ will be required for an RSTO that fails an audit. Failing an audit will also result in a notice of a serious violation. Two or more audit failures may result in suspension or revocation of certifications.

(800) CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

~~a) RSTO and RST Tester certifications must be renewed annually on or before June 30th.~~

~~are valid from July 1st through June 30th of the following year.~~

~~RSTO and RST Tester certifications and contracts with the Department must be renewed annually.~~

~~a) Renewal applications are due on June 1st of each year and must be received no later than June 30th. The Department will not renew the certification of an RSTO or an RST Tester whose application is received after June 30th. The Department will not allow honor tests entered into access to the system DRIVES after June 30th completion forms issued by such an RSTO whose application is not certification is received on or before after June 30th.~~

~~b) Renewal applications are due on June 1st of each calendar year. Failure to submit a sufficient application on or before June 1st may result in an RSTO's or RST Tester's certification not being renewed, and the Department will not honor exams entered into DRIVES by the RSTO or RST Tester on or after July 1st.~~

- ~~e)~~ An RSTO must submit a current Colorado Bureau of Investigation background check for each certified employee annually with its renewal packet.

- c) If an applicant's Examination or RST testing was improper, illegal, or fraudulent, the Department may cancel the applicant's motorcycle endorsement.

~~d) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this rule 9, pursuant to section 24-4-104(4), C.R.S., where the Department has objective and reasonable grounds to believe and finds, upon a full investigation, that an RSTO or RST Tester has been guilty of a deliberate and willful violation, or that the public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates the findings in its order, it may summarily suspend the certification of the RSTO or RST Tester pending Tester pending proceedings for suspension or revocation which shall be promptly instituted and determined. For purposes of this subsection, "full investigation" means a reasonable ascertainment of the underlying facts on which the Department's action is based.~~
