Proposed Changes with Statement of Basis, Purpose, and Authority

Basis. The general authority for promulgation of rules and regulations by the Colorado Podiatry Board is set forth in C.R.S. 12-32-104(1)(a), and specific authority for these rules is set forth in C.R.S. 12-32-109.3(1) and (2).

Purpose: The following rules and regulations have been adopted by the Colorado Podiatry Board in order to provide for the utilization of physician assistants by licensed podiatrists and set forth rules for delegation of podiatric tasks and supervision of physician assistants working under the supervision of licensed podiatrists.

Scope. These rules govern the licensure and conduct of certified physician assistants and not persons performing delegated podiatric tasks pursuant to C.R.S. 12-32-109(7).
