## **Colorado Department of Revenue Division of Motor Vehicles**

### **Statement of Re-Adoption**

Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act, Title 24, Article 4, C.R.S., as amended, I, Roxy Huber, Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Revenue, am promulgating the following rule on behalf of the Division of Motor Vehicles:

1 CCR 204- 12, rules and regulations for Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Third Party Testing.

The purposes of these rules are to ensure compliance with state and federal requirements to promote the safety and welfare of the citizens of Colorado.

A public hearing was held on August 7, 2008. Several companies were represented at this hearing and changes were made to the original rule after a meeting between DMV's Motor Carrier Services and myself. The Attorney General's opinion was due the 6<sup>th</sup> of October and the AG's office provided their response on Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The rules will become effective on November 30, 2008. The AG's office will need to provide an opinion prior to the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2008.
