
EMERGENCY RULEMAKING JUSTIFICATION

S.B. 11-051 was passed during the past legislative session and allows Central Collection Services to offset Gaming and Lottery proceeds to pay towards outstanding debts owed to state agencies assigned to Central Collection Services to collect on their behalf.

This legislation took effect on January 1, 2012.

Funds are currently available for intercept through Gaming and Lottery intercepts. Colorado State Agencies are entitled to these funds and need them to satisfy delinquent accounts receivables on their financial books. In some cases, these funds are paid as restitution to victims of crimes, in other cases to custodial parents for child support, and in other cases as available funding to other students trying to attend Higher Education Institutions, as well as many other scenarios.

The funds currently available for intercept may be delayed or unavailable altogether if the emergency rulemaking is not approved.
