NOTICE OF RULEMAKING HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) will consider a change to Rule 201A concerning the date on which amendments to the Commission's rules adopted in December 2008 shall become effective on federal land in Colorado.

The Commission will consider amending Rule 201A to change the effective date of such amendments on federal land from May 1, 2009 to July 1, 2009. On April 14, 2009, the Commission adopted a temporary rule amendment changing the effective date of such amendments on federal land to July 1, 2009, based on a finding that immediate adoption of such amendment is imperatively necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, or welfare and that compliance with the procedural requirements for permanent rulemaking would be contrary to the public interest. See Section 24-4-103(6), C.R.S. That temporary amendment was published promptly and took effect immediately, and it will expire at midnight on June 30, 2009.

The authority for the proposed amendment is House Bills 07-1298 and 07-1341, codified at sections 34-60-106 and 34-60-128, C.R.S., of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act ("Act"). Additional authority for the promulgation of these amendments is provided by sections 34-60-102, 34-60-103, 34-60-104, 34-60-105, 34-60-108, and 34-60-120, C.R.S., of the Act.
