NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING BEFORE THE COLORADO BOARD OF HEALTH

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on **October 21, 2009** in the Sabin-Cleere Conference Room of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Bldg. A., First Floor, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, Denver, Colorado to consider promulgation of **amendments to 6 CCR 1007-1, Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control, to change Part 20 – Particle Accelerators and Therapeutic Radiation Machines in the Healing Arts, to Part 20 – Reserved.** The Board meeting commences in the morning. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on the proposed revision of *Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control*, Part 20. The proposed revision removes the current rules pertaining to Particle Accelerators and Therapeutic Radiation Machines in the Healing Arts from Part 20 and makes Part 20 a placeholder (Part 20 – Reserved). The content of Part 20 is to be moved to a new Part 24, in order to conform to the regulation sequence of the Suggested State Regulations for Control of Radiation (SSRCR) of the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc.

The proposed rules have been developed by Radiation Control Program, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division ("Division"), Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, pursuant to Sections 25-1-108, 25-1.5-101(1)(l), and 25-11-104, C.R.S.

The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments, or by making oral comments at the hearing. At the discretion of the Chair, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to five minutes or less depending on the number of persons wishing to comment.
