NOTICE OF RULE MAKING HEARING

Pursuant to Section 24-4-103 and Section 12-32-104(1)(a), C.R.S., you are hereby advised that the Colorado Podiatry Board will hold a rule making hearing on Friday, September 10, 2010 at 9:30 a.m., in Conference Room 110A, 1560 Broadway, Denver, Colorado 80202, for consideration of the following:

Revision of 3 CCR 712-1 (Rule 100) regarding the rules and regulations for podiatry licensure;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-3 (Rule 120) regarding the rules and regulations on license reinstatement and the demonstration of continued professional competence;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-4 (Rule 130) regarding the rules on podiatry residency programs;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-10 (Rule 140) regarding license renewal procedures;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-6 (Rule 220) regarding the rules concerning financial responsibility standards;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-11 (Rule 240) regarding the rules on maintenance of current address;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-13 (Rule 290) regarding the rules for further defining the scope of practice of podiatry in Colorado;

Revision of 3 CCR 712-8 (Rule 400) regarding the supervision of and practice by physician assistants (PAs);


Adoption of Rule 135 regarding rules on the podiatry training license and the good faith temporary podiatry training license; and

Repeal of 3 CCR 712-7 (Rule 230) regarding exceptions to initial decisions and related matters

The proposed rules under consideration are attached to this notice and fully incorporated herein. The Board will also consider other proposed amendments, modifications and revisions.

The Board encourages interested parties to submit written comments to the letterhead address regarding any of the above-listed rulemaking matters no later than August 23, 2010. In addition, at the time and place designated in this notice, the Colorado Podiatry Board will afford interested parties an opportunity to submit written information, data, views or arguments. The Board also will afford interested parties an opportunity to make brief oral presentations unless the Board in its discretion determines that such oral presentations are unnecessary. All submissions will be considered. The rules under consideration may be changed or modified after public comment and hearing.
