## NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING BEFORE THE COLORADO BOARD OF HEALTH

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on September 19, 2012 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Room of the Pueblo City-County Health Department, 101 West 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Pueblo, CO 81003, to consider the repeal of 6 CCR 1011-1, Chapter XII, Chiropractic Centers and Hospitals. The Board meeting commences in the morning. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on the repeal of 6 CCR 1011-1, Chapter XII, Chiropractic Centers and Hospitals. The proposed repeal is being requested because of new legislation that removed the Department's authority to license and set standards for chiropractic centers and hospitals.

The proposed repeal has been developed by the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to House Bill 12-1294 which amended Section 25-1.5-103(a)(1)(A), C.R.S. (2012).

The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments, or by making oral comments at the hearing. At the discretion of the Chair, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to five minutes or less depending on the number of persons wishing to comment.
