NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING BEFORE THE COLORADO BOARD OF HEALTH

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on November 21, 2012 in the Sabin-Cleere Conference Room of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Bldg. A, First Floor, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive, South, Denver, CO 80246, to consider the promulgation of 6 CCR 1007-1, Colorado Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control, Part 5, *Radiation Safety Requirements for Industrial Radiographic Operations*. The Board meeting commences in the morning. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on 6 CCR 1007-1, Colorado Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control, Part 5, *Radiation Safety Requirements for Industrial Radiographic Operations*. The proposed rules (amendments) are to align Colorado regulations with those of 10 CFR Part 34 which have changed slightly since Part 5 was last amended. Additional changes are necessary to correct prior cross-reference and typographical errors and make clarifications to certain provisions. Refer to the draft Statement of Basis and Purpose for Part 5 for additional information.

The proposed rules have been developed by the Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Section 25-1.5-101(1)(l), 25-1-108(1)(c), and 25-11-104, C.R.S.


