## NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING BEFORE THE COLORADO BOARD OF HEALTH

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on January 16, 2013, at 10 a.m., in the Sabin-Cleere Conference Room of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Bldg. A, First Floor, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive, South, Denver, CO 80246.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on 6 CCR 1014-9, Colorado Minimum Quality Standards for Public Health Services. The proposed rule establishes minimum quality standards for public health services offered by local public health agencies across Colorado.

The proposed rules have been developed by the Office of Planning and Partnerships of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Section 25-1-503(1)(b), C.R.S.

At the discretion of the Chair, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to five minutes or less depending on the number of persons wishing to comment.
