**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF  
PERMANENT RULES**

The State Personnel Director (“Personnel Director”) will hold a public hearing on March 18, 2013 to consider adoption of permanent rules on the Department of Personnel & Administration Accounts Receivable Collections Administrative Rule.

The March 18, 2013 public hearing will commence at 9:00 a.m. at 633 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 2ABC, Denver, Colorado 80202. Room 2ABC is on the north end of the 633 17<sup>th</sup> St. Lobby accessible by a side elevator located beside Health Partners.

All interested persons are invited to attend this public hearing and to submit comments to the Personnel Director for consideration concerning the proposed rules.

The Director will take comments as follows:

1. In order to facilitate review of written comments by the Personnel Director, all interested parties are encouraged to submit their written comments prior to the hearing:


2. Written comments submitted prior to the hearing must be submitted to Greg Mechem at 633 17<sup>th</sup> St. Suite 1540, Denver CO 80202-3604 or by e-mail at [greg.mechem@state.co.us](mailto:greg.mechem@state.co.us) on or before 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday March 13, 2013.
3. Oral comments may be provided at the hearing as follows:
  - a. All persons wishing to provide oral comment must sign up to do so at the hearing, noting who they represent.
  - b. Any person signing up to speak may cede any portion or all of their time to another speaker.
  - c. At her discretion, the Personnel Director may limit or extend the time of any speaker.

Reasonable accommodation will be provided upon request for persons with disabilities.
