## NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING BEFORE THE COLORADO BOARD OF HEALTH

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on February 19, 2014 at 10 a.m. in the Sabin-Cleere Conference Room of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), Bldg. A, First Floor, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive, South, Denver, CO 80246, to consider the repeal of 6 CCR 1016-1, Nurse Home Visitor Program. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on the repeal of 6 CCR 1016-1, Nurse Home Visitor Program pursuant to HB13-1117, wherein the program was transferred from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to the Colorado Department of Human Services effective July 1, 2013. The Nurse Home Visitor Program is no longer administered by CDPHE, and CDPHE no longer has statutory authority to promulgate rules through the Board of Health. The proposed rules were developed by the Prevention Services Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to 25-31-101, C.R.S. et. seq. The rules are being repealed pursuant to HB13-1117.

The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments, or by making oral comments at the hearing. At the discretion of the Chair, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to five minutes or less depending on the number of persons wishing to comment.

**PURSUANT TO 6 CCR 1014-8, §3.02.1, WRITTEN TESTIMONY MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE Board no later than five (5) calendar days prior to the rulemaking hearing.** Persons wishing to submit written comments should submit them to: Colorado Board of Health, ATTN: Jamie L.
