Notice of Public Rule-Making Hearing Scheduled for September 16, 2015

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Executive Director will conduct a public rule-making hearing on September 16, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. at the Hilton Garden Inn, Denver/Cherry Creek, 600 S. Colorado Blvd, Denver, CO 80246, to consider the promulgation of amendments to 6 CCR 1009-1, Epidemic and Communicable Disease Control, Regulation 10. The proposed rules concern the cleaning, sterilization and sanitation standards for acupuncture and adjunctive therapies. The proposed rules have been developed by the Disease Control and Environmental Epidemiology Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Section 12-29.5-111, C.R.S.

The agenda for the meeting and the proposed repeal will also be available on the Board of Health's website, <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/executive-director-rule-making-hearings> at least 7 days prior to the meeting. The proposed repealed rule, together with the proposed statement of basis and purpose, specific statutory authority and regulatory analysis will be available for inspection at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South EDO-A5, Denver, Colorado 80246-1530 at least five working days prior to the hearing. The Executive Director encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments, or by making oral comments at the hearing. At the Executive Director's discretion, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to three minutes or less depending on the number of persons wishing to comment. Written testimony is due by 5:00p.m., Thursday, September 10, 2015.
