**RE: Open Comment for 8 CCR 1507-28, the Port of Entry Rules for Commercial Motor Carrier Size, Weight and Clearance**

Dear Stakeholders and Colleagues:

If you are receiving this letter, you have been identified as either an interested party or potential stakeholder having interest in 8 CCR 1507-28, the Port of Entry Rules for Commercial Motor Carrier Size, Weight and Clearance (“POE Rules”).

The Colorado State Patrol (CSP) Port of Entry Section is preparing to propose amendments to 8 CCR 1507-28, the POE Rules, and invites all interested parties and stakeholders to participate in this process. Included with this letter is a copy of these rules with the proposed amendments. All proposed deletions appear in “strike-out” text and all other amendments appear in capitalized red text. The POE Rules are being amended to address minor issues including inadvertent omissions; clarification of applicability; and correction of grammatical and formatting errors.
