

Notice of Public Rule-Making Hearing April 17, 2024

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on April 17, 2024 at 10 a.m. held in person at 4300 Cherry Creek Drive S., Denver, CO 80246 or over Zoom at this <u>link</u>; to consider the revision of four rules that contain requirements concerning providing proof of lawful presence to access state public benefits that were repealed by the Colorado General Assembly in Senate Bill 21-199. These four rules include:

- 6 CCR 1011-1 Standards for Hospitals and Health Care Facilities: Chapter 2, General Licensure Standards,
- 6 CCR 1011-1 Standards for Hospitals and Health Care Facilities: Chapter 26, Home Care Agencies
- 6 CCR 1015-3, Emergency Medical Services: Chapter 1, Rules Pertaining to EMS and EMR Education, EMS Certification of Licensure, and EMR Registration
- 6 CCR 1015-3, Emergency Medical Services: Chapter 5, Rules Pertaining to Air Ambulance Licensing.

The proposed rules have been developed by the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Section 24-76.5-103, C.R.S.

The agenda for the meeting and the proposed amendments will also be available on the Board's website, <u>https://cdphe.colorado.gov/board-of-health</u> at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting. The proposed rules, together with the proposed statement of basis and purpose, specific statutory authority and regulatory analysis will be available for inspection at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South EDO-A5, Denver, Colorado 80246-1530 at least five days prior to the hearing. The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments. Written testimony is encouraged; oral testimony will be received only to the extent the Board finds it necessary. For those that are permitted to provide oral testimony, the time may be limited to 3 minutes or less. Testimony is limited to the scope of the rulemaking hearing. Pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-8, §3.02.1, written testimony must be submitted no later than five (5) calendar days prior to the rulemaking hearing. Written testimony must be received by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, April 11, 2024.
