Medical Transportation Reimbursement Rates

Effective March 1, 2012, reimbursement rates for emergency and non-emergency medical transportation services will be reduced by 1%. This proposed reduction is to make up for a 1% proposed reduction that the Department intended to take effect on July 1, 2010, but was not approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

This decrease is expected to result in an aggregate decrease in expenditures in SFY 2011-12 of approximately \$38,087 and an aggregate decrease in expenditures in SFY 2012-13 of approximately \$127,641.

An updated fee schedule reflecting these rate changes will be posted on the Department's Web site at www.colorado.gov/hcpf upon approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
