Enrollment Cap Increase – Adults without Dependent Children Waiver

Effective April 1, 2013, the Department intends to increase the enrollment cap on the Adults without Dependent Children (AwDC) waiver program. Enrollment for the program is currently limited to 10,000 individuals. An additional 9,250 slots will be added to the enrollment cap for a total of 19,250. This expansion will be accomplished by incremental monthly increases over a six-month period, beginning in April 2013. The increased enrollment will allow additional uninsured Coloradans to access health care through Colorado Medicaid's Accountable Care Collaborative. The AwDC program is funded by Colorado's hospital provider fee revenue, along with federal matching funds, and all proposed increases are subject to availability of funding within the hospital provider fee. All other AwDC program policies and processes will remain the same.
