Shared Savings in the Accountable Care Collaborative (“ACC”)

Effective October 1, 2013 the Department intends to submit a State Plan Amendment that will create a shared savings program in the ACC. Regional Care Collaborative Organizations (RCCOs) and eligible providers may receive a portion of savings accrued above the medical and administrative costs of the ACC program as compared to a fee for service benchmark. The amounts distributed will in part depend on the providers’ relative statewide performance on quality measures and the number of Medicaid clients served. Effective October 1, 2013, the Department will begin a measurement phase of one year to determine actual performance.

Over the past two years, the Department has worked closely with providers participating in the ACC and other stakeholders to develop this program. The design of the distribution methodology incorporates all aspects of the ACC and participating RCCOs and PCMPs.

All Primary Care Medical Providers (“PCMPs”) in the ACC are eligible for payments. Once a provider is designated as a PCMP, their participation in the shared savings program is automatic.
