## ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

The Motion to Stay asserts that the parties "are engaged in good faith negotiation on the terms of a settlement agreement to resolve the allegations in the Division's complaint" and need more time to finalize the agreement. I find that there is "good cause" for a continuance of thirty days, as allowed by § 1-45-111.7(6)(a), C.R.S., to finalize settlement of the case. Campaign & Political Finance Rule 24.5.1, 8 Code Colo. Regs. 1505-6.

The Motion to Stay is GRANTED. This matter is stayed for thirty days, pending finalization of the settlement agreement. If no settlement is reached, Respondent is ordered on or before July 12, 2024 to file an Answer to the June 10, 2024 Administrative Complaint.
