
ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

1. Complainant filed an Administrative Hearing Officer Complaint April 28, 2025. The Complaint alleges violations of Colo. Const. xxviii, §3(1) and §1-45-108(3) and §1-45-108(1)(a)(I), C.R.S. of the Fair Campaign Practices Act (FCPA) in connection with contributions and expenditures in the 2024 election cycle.


2. The parties jointly move for additional time to complete briefing on Respondent's June 12, 2025 Motion to Dismiss. The Motion for Enlargement of Time is GRANTED. The new date for Respondent to file its response to the Motion to Dismiss is July 3, 2025 and for the reply July 17, 2025.


