Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVIII of the constitution of the state of Colorado is amended by the addition of a new section to read:

Section 15.

The State of Colorado shall not restrict the ability of local governments to enact regulations, including but not limited to impact fees, requiring that any new development must pay for the costs that these developments incur within the boundaries of municipal governments, county governments, school districts or special districts. Such costs include, but are not limited to, the cost of new or expanded infrastructure such as water and sewer services, road construction, or parks and recreational facilities, the cost of services such as the delivery of emergency medical and fire services, and the cost of expanding capacity of local public school systems.


