Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado, Article II, the Bill of Rights of the state constitution, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

The people of Colorado declare and request that all elected public officials in the state, including all state legislators, the governor, attorney general, United States Representatives and United States Senators, oppose by all means available to them as elected officials the adoption or ratification of any international treaty, protocol or other binding agreement which impairs, restricts or regulates the right to keep and bear arms as described in Sec. 13 or any other right contained in this Bill of Rights.
