Colorado Secretary of State

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Colorado is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

Section 9. No public use of water overlying private property. THE PUBLIC HAS NO RIGHT TO THE USE OF NON-NAVIGABLE WATERS OVERLYING PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY.
