Text of Proposal:

Colorado Secretary of State
Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Colorado is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

Section 9. No public use of water overlying private property.

(1) NO PERSON OR VESSEL SHALL ENTER OR USE WATERS OF NON-NAVIGABLE STREAMS OVERLYING PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY.

(2) "VESSEL" MEANS EVERY DESCRIPTION OF WATERCRAFT USED OR CAPABLE OF BEING USED AS A MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY ON THE WATER.
