Text of Proposal:

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Colorado is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

Section 9. No public use of water overlying private property.

AN OWNER OF PRIVATE PROPERTY MAY RESTRICT THE USE OF AND ACCESS TO WATERS OVERLYING THE PRIVATE PROPERTY, INCLUDING THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, OR MAINTENANCE OF ANY SIGNAGE, FENCE, BRIDGE, GRATING, WATER DIVERSION, STORAGE, CONVEYANCE, OR MEASURING DEVICE, WHETHER IN, BELOW, OR ABOVE THE WATERS.
