*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:*

**Section 1.** In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** section Section 32(4) to article II, as such section is proposed in the 2012 ballot initiative concerning limiting the government's ability to burden freedom of religion, as follows:

(4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

(a) "RIGHT TO ACT" MEANS THE ABILITY TO ENGAGE IN ONE OR MORE RELIGIOUS PRACTICES IN THE PRIVACY OF A PERSON'S HOME OR IN THE PRIVACY OF A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION'S ESTABLISHED PLACE OF WORSHIP.

(b) "REFUSAL TO ACT" MEANS THE ABILITY TO REJECT ONE OR MORE RELIGIOUS PRACTICES IN THE PRIVACY OF A PERSON'S HOME OR IN THE PRIVACY OF A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION'S ESTABLISHED PLACE OF WORSHIP.

**Section 2. Effective date.** Section 1 of this initiative shall only take effect if the 2012 ballot initiative concerning limiting the government's ability to burden freedom of religion, is passed by the voters in the 2012 general election.
