Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. In the constitution of the state of Colorado, add section 20 to article XVIII as follows:

Section 20. Prohibition on gambling monopolies.

- (1) NO STATE AGENCY MAY ISSUE OR RENEW A LICENSE TO CONDUCT LEGALIZED GAMBLING IF THE GRANTING OR RENEWAL OF THAT LICENSE WOULD RESULT INGIVE THE LICENSEE'S A MONOPOLY WITHIN ANY COUNTY ON ONE OR MORE TYPES OF GAMBLING TO BE OFFERED BY THE LICENSEE.
- (2) THIS PROHIBITION APPLIES TO ALL FORMS OF LEGALIZED GAMBLING OTHER THAN BINGO, RAFFLES, AND LIVE HORSE RACING, AND SIMULCAST RACING INCLUDING ONTRACK AND OFF-TRACK BETTING ON SUCH RACES.
- (3) This prohibition is effective notwithstanding any other provision of LAW.
