Be in Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article II. section 3 of the Colorado Constitution is amended to read:

SECTION 1. In the constitution of the state of Colorado, amend section 3 of article II as follows:

(3) Inalienable rights. All persons have certain natural, essential, and inalienable rights, among which may be reckoned the right to enjoying and defending their lives and liberties; of acquiring, possessing, and protecting property; and of seeking and obtaining their safety and happiness;

PARENTS HAVE A FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT AND RESPONSIBILITY TO NURTURE AND TO MAKE DECISIONS CONCERNING THE OVERALL CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF THEIR CHILDREN, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO DIRECTING THE EDUCATION, UPBRINGING, INSTRUCTION, RELIGIOUS AND MORAL INSTRUCTION, HEALTH, MEDICAL CARE, WELFARE, PLACE OF HABITATION, COUNSELING, AND PSYCHOLOGICAL AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING OF THEIR CHILDREN.

SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This measure shall be effective on and after the date it is declared by proclamation of the governor to have been adopted by the registered electors of the state and shall apply to instances occurring on or after the effective date.
