Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Constitution, Article XXVIII, **add** Section 17 as follows:

Section 1. Energy choice

ENERGY CHOICE. (1)

ENERGY CHOICE. (1) GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS RESTRICTING OR BANNING COMMON USE PRODUCTS SUCH AS GAS POWERED VEHICLES, STOVES, HEATERS, AND LAWNMOWERS, AS WELL AS PROPANE FUELED PRODUCTS, CREATES SEVERE FINANCIAL, SAFETY AND PRACTICAL BURDENS FOR WORKING CITIZENS. STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT BAN OR RESTRICT PRODUCTS OR SERVICES CURRENTLY IN COMMON USE BASED ON THE ENERGY SOURCE OF THAT PRODUCT OR SERVICE.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect upon proclamation by the Governor announcing the approval, by the registered electors of the state, of the proposed initiative.
