Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In the Colorado Revised Statutes constitution, article XVIII, add 24-77-108 section 16 as follows:

24-77-108 Section 16. Mass transit fees – limitations on assessment. Fees.

- (1) Fees for mass transit. Any fees assessed for the purpose of funding mass transportation such as <u>Bus</u>, light rail, high speed rail, passenger rail or fixed rail projects, and excluding roads, highways, and bridges <u>shall</u>must:
- (a) BE ASSESSED ONLY TO A PERSON WHOSE POINT OF SALE IS WHO MAKES THE TRANSACTION IN AN THE JURISDICTIONS AREA THAT IS SERVED BY SUCH MASS TRANSPORTATION; AND
- (b) BE APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE IN ANY JURISDICTION THE STATE, OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WHERE SUCH FEES WILL BE COLLECTED.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect on upon the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor upon passage by the voters and signature of the Governor.
