Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** section 17 to article XVIII as follows:

Section 17. Right to Private Health Insurance.

- (1) **Definitions.** As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (a) "SINGLE-PAYER INSURANCE" MEANS STATE-ADMINISTERED HEALTH INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES THE SAME HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE STATE.

(2) Single-payer insurance prohibited.

- (a) THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS SHALL NOT:
- (I) BAN ACCESS TO PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE; OR
- (II) REQUIRE RESIDENTS TO CONTRIBUTE TO OR PARTICIPATE IN A SINGLE-PAYER INSURANCE SYSTEM.
- (b) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PROHIBIT THE STATE FROM ADMINISTERING HEALTH CARE PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE QUALIFIED TO RECEIVE BENEFITS THROUGH MEDICAID OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR FEDERALLY FUNDED PROGRAM.
